Future plans include a large picnic table under a shaded arbor, storage shed, greenhouse and gazebo. Another project will be a brick paved walkway from the entrance which will be funded by and feature Memorial bricks from members of the community. Maybe you would like to remember someone with a Memorial brick! We are also looking for individuals, schools and organizations that might be interested in creating murals to be displayed on the garden fence. The Garden is well on its way toward becoming an outdoor community center for the Bay Point and greater Ambrose Recreation & Park District community.

Garden Boxes are now available to interested gardeners. Many of the boxes come with plants already growing to give you a head start or you can start fresh. If you don't need a specific garden box, but want to become involved with the garden you would be most welcome. We have a number of projects that need financial support and volunteer help. Individuals, businesses and organizations that help will be recognized on posted plaques at the garden.
